7. Explanation of the Change:

This program modification reflects changes in the System General Education and the removal of DSU Institutional Graduation Requirements. CSC 105 and CSC 123 or CSC 150 or CIS 130 are being added to the required course listing. Electives are being decreased to accommodate the increase of 6 credits of System General Education. ECON 201 and ECON 202 are specified as a System General Education Goal 3 course and ECON 202 is specified as a System General Education Elective. BADM 101 and BADM 220 are being added to required courses. CIS 210 is being added to the choose from list and CSC 209 is being removed.
