## 7. Explanation of the Change:

This program modification reflects changes in the System General Education and the removal of DSU Institutional Graduation Requirements. ECON 201 and SOC 285 are being added to the BBA core. CSC 105 and CSC 150/CSC 123/CIS 130 are being added to the major course listings. CSC 150 is a prerequisite for CIS 251 which is in the BS in Professional Accountancy major and students in the BBA Accounting majors often times double major. OED prefix is being removed from the choose from list option in the Management and Marketing majors as DSU no longer offers OED prefix courses. The open electives decrease from 10 to 9. Because of ACBSP Accreditation for this major the percent of courses taken as general education is mandated by percentages, so the proposed changes in this major keeps within those requirements.
