7. Explanation of the Change:

This program modification reflects changes in the System General Education and the removal of DSU Institutional Graduation Requirements. CSC 105 and CSC 150 are being added to the required course listing. ECON 201 was a required course in the system general education and that course is being added to the core, however, a student can still take the course as part of their general education and have an additional elective. Open elective increases from 16 to 18.
