**7. Explanation of the Change:**

CSC 105 is being moved into the major. RESP 381 Management is being deleted from the A.S. program and moving its content to the RESP 495 course in the B.S. program, since most managers of respiratory care departments are at the B.S. level.

Because of the outside accreditation requirements, students in this major will not be required to take three credits in Social Sciences, three credits in Arts and Humanities and ENGL 201 from the Goal one. Therefore, their credits for system general education will remain at 17. The removal of RESP 381 also decreases the overall credits for this major by one credit.
