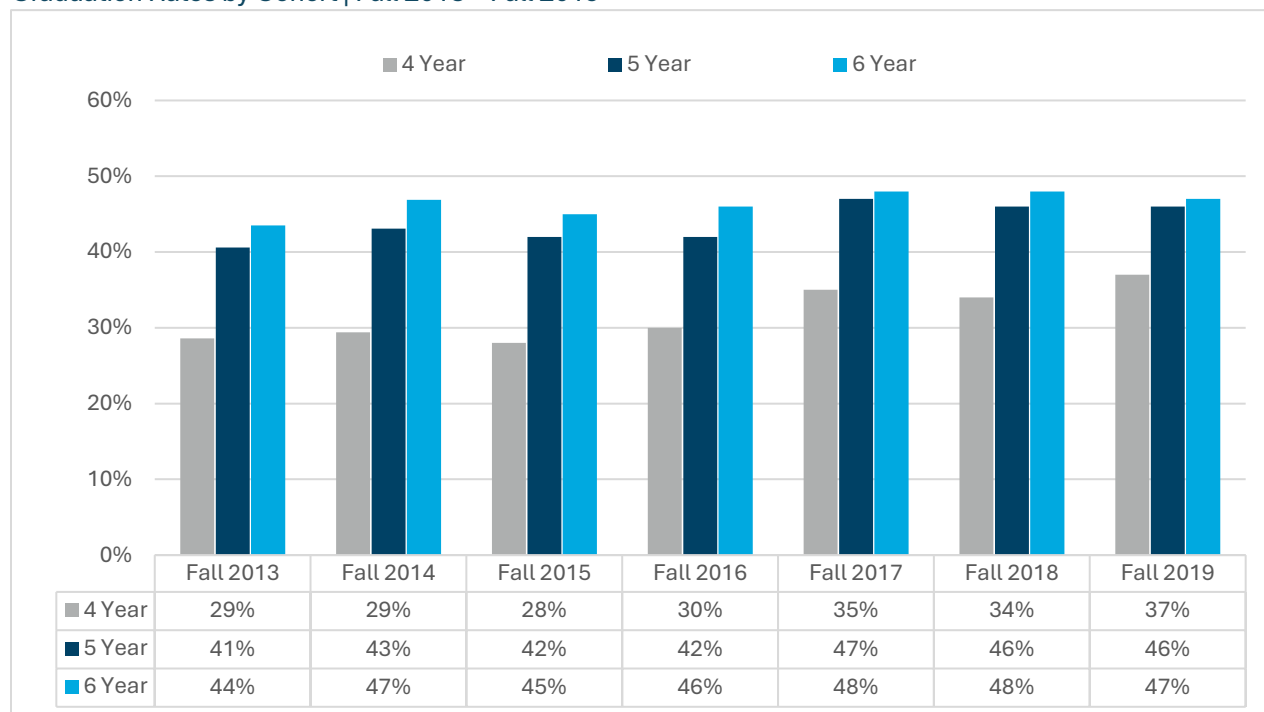
First-Time, Full-Time Bachelor's Degree-Seeking Students

Methodology

Graduation rates are reported in accordance with the U.S. Department of Education's Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The rates represent the percentage of first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduate students who earned a bachelor's degree from Dakota State University within 4, 5, or 6 years of initial enrollment.

These rates do not include transfer students, part-time students, or students who first enrolled at another institution.
